

Data Protection

We appreciate your interest in our website. Protecting your privacy when processing personal data and the security of all business data is a major concern which is considered in all of our business processes. We hereby want to inform you in detail about the handling of your data.

Collection and processing of personal data

Data collected through this Website are treated in accordance with the provisions of the German Data Protection Act ("Bundesdatenschutzgesetz, BDSG") and the Information and Telecommunications Services Act ("Informations- und Telekommunikationsdienstegesetz, IuKDG"). Personal data will only be stored related to the purpose, e. g. as part of an e-mail request, if they have been approved and released by you. A disclosure of personal data to third parties without express consent of the person concerned is excluded. However, we reserve to disclose information if we are required for this purpose by law, or if we are requested to the publication of lawful acting authorities or law enforcement agencies.

In addition, the following information will be collected when you visit our website: website from which the visit is carried out (referrer); visited pages (pages); downloaded files (downloads); view of video/audio; click on individual links, keywords or search phrases (sitesearch); duration of the visit; used browser. If the visit has been carried out on online advertising, e. g. banners, video ads, search engine advertising, we also register what banner has motivated the search of the ATIS-internet site. With this knowledge we can optimize our website and better realize the needs of our visitors.

Use of cookies

To facilitate the use of our website, we use "cookies". Cookies are small text files that can be stored by your browser on your computer hard drive and are helpful for the use of our website are. We use cookies to better to understand how our site is used and to allow improved navigation. For example, cookies help us to determine whether a page on our website has already been visited. Moreover, cookies enable us to recognize whether our website has been visited previously by you or if you are a new visitor. Cookies do not store your personal data. You can set your internet browser so that the storage of cookies is prevented on your hard drive or you will be asked each time if you agree to the set of Cookies. Cookies once set, you can always be deleted. For more information, please refer to the user guide for your browser.

Data protection statement for the use of Google Analytics

This website uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google Inc. ("Google"). Google Analytics uses. "Cookies", text files that are stored on your computer, to help analyze how users use the website. Processing of personal data in a job application

Your application will be treated in confidence and will only be disclosed to the competent employees of the company.

Unless you have agreed to store your data for other interesting jobs, your application data will be deleted six months after completion of the application process. If you have consented to the storage of your data, your application data will be deleted no later than 2 years from the end of the application year. Likewise, your application will be deleted when an employment contract has been agreed to. In this case, the documents submitted will be saved to your personnel file.
